(*Non-reservable site) Here are some important things to remember for your wilderness backpack camping experience in Newport State Park:

- You must register and pay all fees before setting up camp. If office is closed, self-register outside of park office. You must park in designated lots and have a valid WI State Park vehicle sticker.
- Allow ample time to reach site before dark. Tents must be set up in designated areas, not on shoreline. One family or no more than 6 people per site. Pit toilets are located near each site.
- Camp stoves are preferred. All other fires must be within fire ring (do NOT move ring). Only dead or downed wood may be used from park. When leaving, be sure fire is completely out.
- Drinking water must be carried in (or use filter if water is accessible). All leftover food, garbage and recyclables must be carried out. Dumpsters are located at the service building parking lot. Use steel storage box to protect food and/or belongings from small animals.
