

EXPLORE WISCONSIN STATE PARKS: DOOR COUNTY, WI

TRAIL-GATING CHECKLIST

Kick off your day of adventure by checking out the spectacular view from the Old Ski Hill overlook at **Potawatomi State Park**.

Up for tackling a challenge? Hike to the top of Old Baldy, the tallest sand dune in Wisconsin (93 feet tall) at **Whitefish Dunes State Park**.

Gain some yardage (and elevation) when you ascend Eagle Tower at **Peninsula State Park**. Take the stairs or the fully accessible canopy walk to the top for breathtaking views.

Head north to **Newport State Park** for night sky viewing at Wisconsin's only International Dark Sky Park. Is that Bart Star(r) hanging out by the Dark Sky kiosk at Lot 3?

While at **Newport**, check out the crooked tree (it kind of looks like a goalpost) and do the Lynd Point Leap. Look for a sign on the trail.

Go the extra yard and snap a selfie in **any of Door County's state parks**.

Stop in at the Newport park office between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Thursday (**April 24**), Friday (**April 25**) or Saturday (**April 26**). Bring your checklist and/or photos of your trip to collect a green and gold sticker!
